Good Morning TJ, the new training requirement will go into effect on September 1, 2010. This requirement will be in lieu of the training program currently in place. This change is in accordance with CPC 12050(a)(1)(E) which authorizes the licensing authority to require a community college course certified by the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST). This course will be the only course acceptable to the Sheriff's Department for new license applicants and for license renewal applicants.

Melissa: I just received the attached from the OCSD. It raises several questions:

1. Is this requirement from Commander Trujillo in place of the 16 hour course we normally give? Or in addition to the live-fire course?
2. Are we required to verify the applicants completion of the community college class or are YOU charged with that responsibility.
3. If we are going to continue offering the live-fire component, should we delete any discussion of the laws and lethal force from our curriculum?
4. If we are going to continue offering the live-fire component, does it matter what order they take the new community college class, whether before or after the live-fire class?
